As a Pharmacist, the successful candidate will be involved in providing comprehensive antiretroviral (ART) pharmaceutical services.

- Overall coordination/supervision of day-to-day of ART/HIV pharmacy operations
- Provide clinical support and medication information to ART patients
- Provide pharmaceutical HIV care continuum services
- Support ART management at both district/regional and facility level
- Support the roll out and use of the electronic dispensing tool (EDT), community adherence groups, and community-based ART services (CBART)
- Ensure availability of ARVs and other pharmaceutical commodities
- Ensure commodities received by the pharmacy meet the quality assurance requirements
- Participate in forecasting, planning, and quantification of sexual transmitted infections (STI) medicines, commodities, ARVs, and opportunistic infection medicine requirements for the district/region.
- Liaise with regional pharmacist regarding commodity and logistics management
- Participate in review meetings with the clinical team
- Coordinate district therapeutic committee meetings
- Supervise and support district staff to ensure the implementation of decentralised ART pharmaceutical services
- Ensure availability of minimum stock levels at both district/regional and facility level
- Participate in planning and implementation of treatment, care, and support program activities
- Collaborate with other service delivery areas and partners working in the HIV response sector
- Work closely with data clerks to validate EDT and EPMs data
- Collaborate with the district Health Information System (HIS) personnel in monitoring and evaluating data
- Participate in clinical team training and technical supervisory support visits
- Collect and analyse reports from hospitals regarding pharmaceutical supplies and commodities
- Serve as a link between the district pharmacy department and the regional pharmacist
- Perform all other lawful and reasonable duties as instructed by the reporting line
