You will be responsible for strengthening the clinical capacity of the district to prepare and effectively respond to COVID-19 and any other outbreaks, especially focused on IPC measures. You will produce weekly IDSR reports, support all surveillance activities in the district, and assist with community mobilization activities.

Key focus areas:

- Conduct day-to-day technical and operational activities to prepare and respond to COVID-19 diseases and other related situations.
- Provide timely training and support to continuously inform risk assessment in health care facilities to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- Produce weekly IDSR and other related reports for health conditions and disseminate to partners.
- Support district level response to co-ordinate quarantine data and contact tracing.
- Support all surveillance activities in the district.
- Assist with compilation of district readiness report.
- Support the district in the implementation of response guidelines and standard operating procedures.
- Assist district to operationalize standard operating procedures for the response.
- Assist with community mobilization activities.
- Perform other tasks as delegated by the Supervisor.
